

## Safety Equipment and Training Grant

APRA’s emphasis on safety is reflected in our Loss Control Grant Program. Investment in safety equipment and training helps raise awareness of the importance of safety and its value to employees. APRA offers grants starting at \$250 to be applied to safety training or equipment, including personal protective equipment.

Receiving the grant is easy! Simply complete the **Safety Grant Application** and submit it, along with the receipt from your purchase, to [riskservices@alaskarisk.org](mailto:riskservices@alaskarisk.org).

Our members always have great ideas for this grant. Previous years’ purchases include travel costs to attend training, winter snow cleats, automated emergency defibrillators (AED), police and fire gear, and various personal protective equipment. If you’re having trouble figuring out how to use the grant, review your employees’ hazard assessments and find out what personal protective equipment may be needed.

The amount of the grant available to members varies based on the member’s 2025/26 contribution paid to APRA, as described in the table below:

Total Member Contribution	Safety Grant Amount Available
Less than \$25,000	\$250
\$25,001 - \$100,000	\$500
\$100,001 - \$500,000	\$1,000
\$500,000 - \$1,000,000	\$2,000
\$1,000,001 - \$2,000,000	\$3,000
\$2,000,001 - \$3,000,000	\$4,000
\$3,000,001 - \$5,000,000	\$5,000



**Here’s one of our favorite picks for spending that money—snow and ice cleats to stop those winter slips and falls!** Many kinds are available: light and heavy duty, for dress shoes and work shoes, and with costs ranging from \$20 to \$50.

*The Safety Grant Application must be signed by the entity’s city manager, superintendent, or other designated administrator.*
